Leerdoelen:

At the end of this course the student is able to:

- understand simple everyday Dutch
- engage in simple everyday conversations
- write different types of texts (e.g. book reports, letters, essays)

Inhoud

- This course is offered for students who have a global understanding of and can make themselves understood in simple, everyday Dutch.
- The course focuses on improving and developing students' functional Dutch language skills. Students will learn, for example, to tell where they live, to describe the Dutch landscape, to give their opinion on something, etc.
- By using multi-media the teacher provides learners with opportunities to develop the four language skills; listening, reading, writing and speaking. In addition to the course book, we will use authentic language material (e.g. newspaper articles, film, Dutch songs, poems).
- Lessons incorporate information about Dutch culture and society wherever possible.
